The sowing season, that began in March, has already borne fruit at the outset of autumn.

Our farmers have dedicated themselves to reap an abundant harvest of raw cotton.

Farmers grow cotton that is processed at the cotton gin plant and then sent to Indorama Kokand Textiles for yarn production. Indorama Agro grew cotton on over 16,000 hectares this year. Including over 8,000 hectares on a contract basis.

Timely agricultural work, seed selection, irrigation, and fertilization led to this result.

Adequate resources and personnel are important for labor-intensive cotton harvesting. This includes the right machinery, a reliable team, and a plan for storing and transporting harvested cotton.

Indorama Agro uses over 40 John Deere tractors and combines for mechanical harvesting. In Kasbi and Nishon, the company hired pickers to hand-collect part of the harvest

Our team monitors compliance with safety regulations in the fields around the clock. They conducted emergency trainings, checked equipment for readiness, and organized food supply areas for combine harvester operators. They have taken precautions at cotton picking points and gin plants.

We expect our harvest to be bountiful.



### COLLECTIVE AGREEMENT APPROVED BY TRADE UNION




The conference of the labor team was held on September 16, 2023, by the committee of the "Indorama Agro" Trade Union in Oqoltin district.

In particular, in Sirdarya and Kashkadarya regions, a series of trainings, interviews and training sessions were organized in cooperation with the representatives of the regional departments of the Ministry of Emergency Situations, the Road Safety Department of the Ministry of Internal Affairs, in order to prepare firefighting equipment for fire safety during the season at each cotton receiving point.

Drivers of the company, employees of cotton receiving points, pickers, tractor drivers, electricians were involved to the trainings and seminars.

2023 cotton harvest season, how the factory is preparing for the cotton harvest and the condition of the fire shields and fire hydrants were reviewed. The operation of fire extinguishing equipment and tools was checked once again.



### INNOVATION AND RECYCLING



Indorama Agro implements recycling efforts to minimize waste production. The company's ginning plants and machinery fleet have extensive operations, necessitating a substantial quantity of spare parts for maintenance. The material is delivered by our global suppliers in wooden boxes and pallet packing that have been treated chemically for durability. Initially, these boxes were disposed of in a landfill by a certified waste collector vendor, in accordance with local environmental regulations.

The IAL Fazli warehouse team implemented an idea to maximize recycling of scrap wooden boxes by making plant stands, achieving the objective of green space and good housekeeping. These plant stands are weatherproof, environmentally friendly, insect-resistant, and renovated in-house with no external help or budget.

Dozens of such plants stand installed in our farm depots and offices.

### TEAM BUILDING THROUGH CRICKET TOURNAMENT

The company held a cricket tournament in Guliston, Syrdarya in September. Four teams represented Indorama Agro operational districts.
